Shubbery overgrown making visibility difficult. Two interior brick chimneys. Sidelights

Alteration Date: 1989-90

Alterations: Window added at façade porch gable end. Rear shed additions. Windows and roof altered post Hugo (1992 survey). Majority of brick poorly repointed, date unknown.
