Significant Architectural Features: Partially engaged square tower centered above entry projection with round louvered vents with keystones at front and side elevations with wide flushboard siding. Belfry tower is also square with gable projections and round-arched louvered vents at all four elevations. The spire, which is clad in metal, is partially engaged with belfry. Stained glass is at rear polygonal elevation. Pedimented trim above windows on south and north elevations of  
Alteration Date: c. 1940  
Alterations: Single-story additions at rear. Lateral gable structure was attached at rear left. Present portico and spire date to c. 1940 and replaced a separate bell tower that stood to the right of the entry portico.
