Significant Architectural Features: 3 gabled dormers on west slope and 2 on east slope--all with wide eaves and 6/6 windows. Porch supported by square chamfered posts; turned balusters; 3 scroll brackets left on porch. Round-headed window in gable end with 6/6 window; all other windows 2/2. Corbelled brick chimneys with terra cotta flues on east slope of roof; one brick flue in original house. One bracket remains on house from the water collection system--per Larry McClellan.

Alteration Date: c.1910, c1950;

Alterations: hipped bay with stained glass windows on south elevation c. 1910. porch of rear portion (original structure) enclosed c. 1950. Windows in that enclosed porch and the entire roof replaced in 2007. Shed addition at rear constructed over original cistern.
